14-041 Motion presented by Councillor Giannino: That the Mayor require the DPW to remove the snow from the sidewalks on Mountain Avenue for public safety reasons, students are having difficulty walking to school.

14-042 Motion presented by Councillor Novoselsky: That the Revere Traffic Commission revise the R.R.O Schedule XVIII of Title 10-Off street parking meter zones by reducing the number of meters to 6 (from 10) on the easterly side of Municipal lot A along the wall of 157 Shirley Ave.

14-043 Motion presented by Councillor Novoselsky: That the Revere Traffic Commission revise the R.R.O Schedule VIII of Title 10 by establishing a 30-minute parking zone from 8 AM to 8PM, Monday through Saturday on the northerly side of Shirley Ave. at numbers 60-64-66 Shirley Ave. The area involved is 30 feet long from a point approximately 20 feet from Thornton St up to 3 feet from the next driveway.

14-044 Motion presented by Councillor Novoselsky: That the Revere Traffic Commission revise the R.R.O Schedule VIII of Title 10 by establishing a 30-minute parking zone from 8 AM to 8PM, Monday through Saturday on the southerly side of Shirley Ave. at number 65 Shirley Ave. The area involved is 30 feet long from a point approximately 20 feet from Thornton St. up to a point 20 feet from Sumner Street (between two trees).

14-045 Motion presented by Councillor Novoselsky: That the Revere Traffic Commission revise the R.R.O Schedule IX of Title 10 "Resident Parking Sticker areas" by establishing 23 spaces in the Shirley Avenue Municipal Lot A. The areas involved shall be the spaces in rows 2, 3 and 4 westerly from 157 Shirley Ave.
