Motions

15-058 Motion presented by Councillors Powers: That the Mayor make arrangements to have the damaged guardrail removed from Mills and Rice Avenues as soon as possible. In its present condition it poses a safety hazard

to the children and residents in the area. Further, that the guardrail be replaced in a timely manner.

15-059 Motion presented by Councillor Morabito: That the Revere City Council present the members of the ABC Club (Anti-Bullying Coalition) at Rumney Marsh Academy (RMA) with a Certificates of Commendation for their anti-bullying efforts by promoting a message of acceptance and tolerance at the RMA and volunteering in the community.
