**15-114 Motion presented by Councillors Haas, Morabito, Arrigo, and Powers: That the Mayor request the DPW to install "Drug Free Zone" signage at the Oak Island Park and any other city park that does not already have "Drug Free Zone" signage.**

**15-115 Motion presented by Councillor Powers: That the Mayor request the Police Department to monitor and enforce traffic regulations to include speeding on Harris Street.**

**15-116 Motion presented by Councillor Powers: That the Mayor direct the appropriate department to make repairs to the roof and the façade of the youth center building at 105 Beach Street.**

**15-117 Motion presented by Councillor Patch: That the Mayor direct Inspectional Services to issue a notice of violation of city ordinances to the owner of 41 Liberty Avenue.
