This new stop would also help eliminate shopping carts being abandoned around the city.

15-213 Motion presented by Councillor Haas: That the Mayor request the Traffic Commission to extend the timing of the traffic light on Malden Street at the intersection of Broadway. The shortness of the duration of the light causes traffic back-ups on Malden Street as far back as the Lincoln School.
