Motions

15-221 Motion presented by Councillor Morabito: That the Mayor declare the month of October as "Bullying Prevention Month" in the City of Revere. Schools and organizations across the country join STOMP Out Bullying in observing National Bullying Prevention Month. The goal: encourage communities to work together to stop bullying and cyberbullying by increasing awareness of the prevalence and impact of bullying on all children of all ages.

15-222 Motion presented by Councillor Patch: That the Mayor request the Traffic Commission to amend Schedule V of Title 10, One-Way Streets, to make Derby Street one-way for the entire length from Squire Road to Malden Street. The current arrangement has been causing traffic tie-ups on Squire Road. Further, that the DPW Sign Department install new one-way signage on Derby Street at the intersections of Squire Road and Derby Street and a right-turn only sign on Derby Street for vehicles exiting the Honey Dew Donuts parking lot.

15-223 Motion presented by Councillor McKenna: That the Mayor request the Traffic Commission to establish resident parking only on Jones Rd., Dolphin, Atlantic, and Unity Avenues due to the close proximity of the MBTA station. These streets are being inundated with people that live outside of the city parking in front of residents' homes for most of the day and taking the train into Boston.
