15-225 4. Hearing called, as ordered, on the application of A Woman's Concern, Inc. dba Learn Your Options, 103 Broadway, Revere, MA seeking permission to install an awning at 103 Broadway.

Motion presented by Councillor Reardon: That the application presented by A Woman's Concern, Inc., d/b/a Learn Your Options, located at 103 Broadway, Revere, MA for the construction of an awning at said premises be approved.

15-224 5. Comm. from the Mayor:

I am hereby requesting the City Council's confirmation of Patricia Melchionno, 79 Sagamore Street, Revere, Ma., as a Constable for the City of Revere.

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 41, Section 9I of the Ma. General Laws, this reappointment is granted for a period of three years,

unless sooner revoked by the Mayor, Chief of Police or the Honorable City Council.

Ms. Melchionno has been advised that the Appointment sub-committee will be contacting her shortly with a date and time to appear before them concerning this reappointment.

Motions

15-221 6. Ordered on a Motion presented by Councillor Morabito: That the Mayor declare the month of October as “Bullying Prevention Month” in the City of Revere. Schools and organizations across the country join STOMP Out Bullying in observing National Bullying Prevention Month. The goal: encourage communities to work together to stop bullying and cyberbullying by increasing awareness of the prevalence and impact of bullying on all children of all ages.

15-222 7. Ordered on a Motion presented by Councillor Patch: That the Mayor request the Traffic Commission to amend Schedule V of Title 10, One-Way Streets, to make Derby Road one-way for the entire length from Squire Road to Malden Street. The current arrangement has been causing traffic tie-ups on Squire Road. Further, that the DPW Sign Department install new one-way Do Not Enter signage on Derby Road at the intersection of Grover Street and a right-turn only sign on Derby Road for vehicles exiting the Honey Dew Donuts parking lot.

15-223 8. Ordered on a Motion presented by Councillor McKenna: That the Mayor request the Traffic Commission to establish resident parking only on Jones Rd., Dolphin, Atlantic, and Unity Avenues due to the close proximity of the MBTA station. These streets are being inundated with people that live outside of the city parking in front of residents’ homes for most of the day and taking the train into Boston.

15-226 9. Ordered on a Motion presented by Councillor Powers: That the Mayor direct the DPW to check the catch basins in the Sagamore St./Dunn Rd./Shawmut St. area to ensure they are free of blockages. Further, that the pump on Dunn Rd. be inspected to ensure that it is operational.

15-227 10. Ordered on a Motion presented by Councillor Powers: That the Mayor request the Department of Planning and Community Development, the City Engineer, and DPW to televise the storm water line that runs from Harrington Avenue to the Rice Avenue pump station to determine its structural integrity. This line services the catch basins in this neighborhood. Further, that the Rice Avenue storm water pump station be rehabbed.

Ordered on a Motion of Councillor Guinasso: That the City Council now stands adjourned to meet on October 19, 2015.
