12-022 Joint meeting of Verizon, National Grid, and Comcast to discuss double poles.

Motions

16-172 Motion presented by Councillor Zambuto: That the Mayor request the Veteran's Department, in conjunction with the DPW, to install memorial pole for Felix S. DeSisto, WWII US Army Air Force Veteran and former Director of Public Health for the City of Revere, at an appropriate location to be determined by the City and family.

16-173 Motion presented by Councillor Guinasso: That the Mayor request Greg Hayward (617-408-6612) of Vivint Solar, 29 Draper St., Woburn, MA 01801 to appear before the City Council at the meeting of June 27, 2016 to discuss Vivint Solar's sales process relative to the installation of home solar energy systems.

16-174 Motion presented by Councillor Rotondo: That the Mayor request our State Delegation to obtain or look into the feasibility of the authentication of the piping plover population on Revere Beach. Further, that the state require, in its authentication, the Audubon Society to provide concise visual and population count of piping plovers to include beach

migratory patterns. Further encroachment of the Audubon Society uncheck or validate assertion creates a hardship for the Jack Satter House residents and potentially decreases the value of properties on Revere Beach Boulevard due to the lack of beach access.

16-099 Motion presented by Councillor Rotondo: That the Mayor provide a response to Council Order 16-099 which was passed by the City Council on April 25, 2016. “That the Mayor provide job titles, lines of authority and salaries of all aides in the Mayor’s Office. Further, that the City Solicitor offer an opinion to the City Council as to where in the City Charter do Mayoral Aides derive their authority, if any? The City Solicitor shall also provide the current statutory lines of authority in the City of Revere, for example Mayor, then Council President then Vice President, etc.”
