Motion presented by Councillor Correggio as amended: That the Mayor request the DPW Superintendent to examine the guidelines used for hiring plow drivers to include but not limited to truck size, equipment, and operator capability. I have received many complaints about undersized trucks plowing during the previous blizzard and complaints about damage to parked vehicles, further that identifying signage be placed on these vehicles indicating City of Revere Hired Plows, in magnetic placards/flags.

Further Ordered, that the DPW Supt. be requested to appear before the Public Works Committee and explain his guidelines for hiring contracted snow plow drivers.

Ordered on a Motion presented by Councillor Arrigo: That the Mayor provide the Council with the following documentation regarding the bond orders required to construct the Staff Sergeant James J. Hill School: Detailed budgets for each of the bond authorizations that were presented to the Council; the City's current debt service schedule (principal/interest/total over the next 20 years before the bonds that were presented to the Council; the City's anticipated debt service schedule (principal/interest/total over the next 20 years including the bonds that are before us); a list of all bonded capital projects the City is still paying for, including: the amount originally authorized, the interest rate the City is paying, the amount that the City has paid to date, the amount the City owes and the projected date that the project would be paid off; a master capital planning document; a list of MSBA reimbursed projects in Revere showing the total budget at the time of the bond authorization, the amount of reimbursement by the MSBA and the final total cost for each project; and a review of the long-term financial impact of the proposed bond authorization from the City's independent auditor Powers & Sullivan.
