1. Roll Call – 4:16 PM
2. Approval of the Minutes of February 6, 2013 motion by Member Vincent Cammarata, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Vice-Chair Joseph James. Voted in the affirmative unanimously.
3. Vote – Land Swap with Rowe Contracting – City of Revere Land Parcel Map 34 Block 468c Lot 7 on Grandview Avenue containing 5,250 sq. ft. for land on Ossen Street being Map 34 Block 473 Lot 229 containing 2,783 sq. ft. and Map 34 Block 473 Lot 232 containing 2,789 sq. ft.. Land to be donated is adjacent to existing North Revere Conservation Land area and will be deeded to the Conservation Commission in perpetuity. – Member Vincent Cammarata asked Mr. Mahoney who represented Rowe Contracting before the Commission about if he planned to build on the land. Mr. Mahoney responded that in the future he would like to. Member Daniel Blustein inquired about the lots adjacent to the land the City of Revere is to receive. Mr. Mahoney informed those present that they are part of the Conservation Land off of Morris Street. Motion by Member Joseph LaValle, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Member Vincent Cammarata. Voted in the affirmative unanimously.
4. Vote – Certificate of Compliance – DEP File #061-0491, 2 & 4 Mermaid Avenue, Revere, MA – Mermaid Avenue Condominium Trust. Motion by Vice-Chair Joseph James, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Member Ann Raponi to schedule a site visit for Saturday, April 27, 2013. Voted in the affirmative unanimously.
5. Vote – Enforcement Order, DEP File #061-0619, 26 Wave Avenue, Maria C. and Robert Tobalino. Motion by Member Vincent Cammarata, 2<sup>nd</sup> by James Cerbone to schedule a site visit for Saturday, April 27, 2013. Voted in the affirmative unanimously.
6. Vote – Motion by Chair Andrew B. DeSantis, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Member Ann Raponi of support of the Revere Conservation Commission to support Member Daniel Blustein’s effort to get Revere On The Move on Revere Beach in conjunction with the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Department of Conservation and Recreation, The Revere Beach Partnership and the City of Revere. Voted in the affirmative unanimously.
