

1. Roll Call – 4:15 PM – Member Joseph LaValle, Member Vincent Cammarata, Vice-Chair Joseph James, Member Ann Raponi, and Chairman Andrew B. DeSantis present. Member Daniel Blustein and Member James Cerbone absent.
2. Approval of the Minutes of July 2, 2013 motion by Member Vincent Cammarata, 2nd by Vice-Chair Joseph James. Voted in the affirmative unanimously.
3. Vote – Land donation by Joseph A. Festa, Elwood Street (End)/Dyke Marsh Lot 16, Map 019 Block 327 Parcel 012 in Revere, Massachusetts. Motion by Member Joseph LaValle, 2nd by Vice-Chair Joseph James. Voted in the affirmative unanimously.
4. Vote – Land donation by Joseph A. Festa Jr., Weeden Street – Map 019 Block 327 Parcel 002 in Revere, Massachusetts. Motion by Vice-Chair Joseph James, 2nd by Member Joseph LaValle. Voted in the affirmative unanimously.
5. Mr Robert Mahoney appeared before the Commission on use of a portion of land under the care and control of the Revere Conservation for the construction of a paved cul-de-sac. Motion by Vice-Chair Joseph James, 2nd by Member Ann Raponi to allow use of portions of Walnut Street designated parcel E (Map 034 Block 472 Lot 7) in the amount of 1,061 square feet and parcel F (Map 031 Block 472 Lot 8) in the amount of 2,798 square feet. Voted in the affirmative unanimously.
6. Vote – Certificate of Compliance, DEP File #061-0626, 24 Vera Street. Motion by Member Joseph LaValle, 2nd by Vice-Chair Joseph James to issue. Voted in the affirmative unanimously.
7. Vote – Certificate of Compliance, DEP File #061-0609, 420 Revere Beach Boulevard. Motion by Member Ann Raponi, 2nd by Member Vincent Cammarata. Voted in the affirmative unanimously.
8. Vote – Notice of Intent, DEP File #061-0640, 50 Broadsound Avenue. Attorney Joseph Cattagio presented on the behalf of the applicant Antonio Dello Iacono. Andrew Burke of 15-16 Peirview Avenue spoke in favor of the proposal. Motion by Vice-Chair Joseph James, 2nd by Member Vincent Cammarata to close the Public Hearing and issue an Order of Conditions. Voted in the affirmative unanimously.
9. Motion by Vice-Chair Joseph LaValle, 2nd by Member Ann Raponi to adjourn. Voted in the affirmative unanimously, adjourned at 4:40 PM.
