



**Revere Conservation Commission
Minutes March 5, 2014

1. Roll Call – 4:19 PM – Member Joseph LaValle, Member Vincent Cammarata, Member Ann Raponi, Member James and Chairman Andrew B. DeSantis present. Vice-Chair Joseph James, Member Daniel Blustein absent.
2. Member Ann Raponi requested the floor to wish Vice-Chair Joseph James well wishes.
3. Approval of the Minutes of December 4, 2013 motion by Member Vincent Cammarata, 2nd by Member Joseph LaValle. Voted in the affirmative unanimously.
4. Public Hearing – Notice of Intent – DEP File #061-0644 – Beach Management Activities, Revere Beach and Short Beach, Department of Conservation and Recreation, Commonwealth of Massachusetts. Motion by Member Ann Raponi, 2nd by Member Vincent Cammarata to open public hearing. Voted in the affirmative unanimously. Nancy Putnam, Director of Ecology Program at DCR initial presented and asked the Commission to permit continued maintenance activities at the beaches. Ray Faucher of DCR spoke to the management of maintenance activities. George Ayoub of DCR spoke on the habitat of the Piping Plover. All commission members posed questions to the DCR personnel. A resident spoke. Motion to close public hearing and issue an Order of Conditions by Member Ann Raponi, 2nd by Member Vincent Cammarata. Voted in the affirmative unanimously.
5. Public Hearing – NOI, DEP File #061-0643, [Sewer System Rehabilitation, Phase 4, Contract WW-002](#), Replacement of Existing Lateral Sewer with approximately 250 linear feet of new 8 inch diameter PVC Sewer Pipe and Construction of a New Submersible Wastewater Pumping Station on Dix Street, City of Revere. Motion by Member Ann Raponi, 2nd by Member Vincent Cammarata to open the public hearing. Voted in the affirmative unanimously. Magdalena Lofstedt of CDB presented on behalf of the City. Motion to close the public hearing and issue an Order of Conditions by Member Ann Raponi, 2nd by Member Joseph Cerbone. Voted in the affirmative unanimously.
6. Public Meeting – [Request for Determination of Applicability City Wide Sewer Repairs, Contract WW-001](#) which includes cleaning and cured-in-place lining of sewer mains, service connection laterals, spot replacement of sewer pies, and manhole rehabilitation in eleven flow meter areas throughout including the Point of Pines, Oak Island, Revere Beach, Squire Road, Malden Street, Broadway and the High School in the City of Revere. Motion by Member Ann Raponi, 2nd by Member Vincent Cammarata to issue negative determination. Voted in the affirmative unanimously.
7. Vote – Request for Certificate of Compliance, DEP File #061-0641, 15 Undine Avenue. Motion by Member James Cerbone, 2nd by Member Vincent Cammarata to issue Certificate of Compliance. Voted in the affirmative unanimously.

8. Vote – Request to withdraw water from Chelsea River for hydrostatic tank testing, Irving Oil Company. Motion by Member Ann Raponi, 2nd by Member Joseph LaValle to grant request. Voted in the affirmative unanimously.
9. Motion by Member Vincent Cammarata, 2nd by Member James Cerbone to adjourn. Voted in the affirmative unanimously, adjourned at 5:34 PM.
