# FILING INSTRUCTIONS FOR A BUSINESS CERTIFICATE (MASSACHUSETTS GENERAL LAWS, CHAPTER 110, SECTION 5) THE CITY OF REVERE MASSACHUSETTS

### WHO MUST FILE?

- Any individual conducting business under any title other than the complete real name of the owner, whether individually or as a partnership.
- Inc., Corp., Ltd., LLC may only be used by a Corporation.
- Any Corporation doing business in a name other than a Corporate Officer must file the corporate name.

### WHERE DO YOU FILE?

- File with the City Clerk's Office, City of Revere, either in person or by mail.
- If in person: All individuals must be present to complete the Business Certificate Form. Photo ID's must also be provided for each individual listed on the Business Certificate Form.
- If by mail: Obtain the Business Certificate Form from the Revere City Clerk's Office. Complete the form, leaving the expiration date blank. Sign the form before a Notary Public. Mail the completed form, a self-addressed stamped, business-size envelope, and the payment (check or moneyorder) made payable to the <u>City of Revere</u> to:

# FEES (Includes one (1) certified copy)

Business Certificate Filing
Withdrawals, Discontinuances, Changes, etc.

#### WHAT ABOUT A CHANGE?

• Upon discontinuing, retiring or withdrawing from such business or partnership, or in the case of a change of residence of such person or of the location where the business is conducted such a change must be filed with the City Clerk.

#### DOES A BUSINESS CERTIFICATE EXPIRE?

• Yes. A Business Certificate is in force and in effect for four (4) years from the date of issue. A new filing must be made every four years as long as the business is conducted.

# DOES THE BUSINESS CERTFICATE HAVE TO BE DISPLAYED?

• No. However, you must provide a copy of the form on request, during regular business hours, to any person who has purchased goods or services from your business.

# ARE THERE PENALTIES?

• Violations of these provisions shall be subject to a fine of not more than three hundred dollars (\$300.) for each month during which such violation continues.
