

PLAN REVERE PUBLIC MEETING

Mission: *Plan Revere commissions a community based visioning process for the City of Revere that focuses on our strongest assets: proximity to Boston, waterfront, and access to public transportation. This process will set the stage for necessary public and private actions to make this vision a reality.*

Outreach Undertaken: Discussions have been ongoing with recognized leaders of key sectors.

Initiatives in Process: The City is now engaged in several initiatives to advance Plan Revere objectives.

- Broadway Revitalization
- Transformative Development Initiative (TDI)
- Revere Beach Creative District
- Harvard GSD Planning Studio

Information Gathering and Research to Continue:

- **Collaboration** with Metropolitan Area Planning Council (MAPC)
- **Further outreach** to experts in respective topic areas

Focus Areas: The visioning process will target critical locations.

- Bell Circle/Wonderland
- Suffolk Downs/Airport Corridor
- Revere Beach/Shirley Avenue
- Beachmont
- Revere Street
- Broadway
- Squire Road Corridor

Areas of Analysis: Plan Revere will focus on the following topics for analysis by target area.

- Housing Options
- Economic Development
- Transportation
- Public Facilities/Public Services

Organizational Structure: The Plan Revere Steering Committee will be separated into four different subcommittees to cover the areas of analysis. The Committee as a whole will at the conclusion of the effort work to design implementation strategies for Plan Revere.

Process: The four sub-committees – will convene and consider and will gather input from experts in respective fields; the end products will be 4 Focus Area reports to be incorporated into Plan Revere.

Next Steps: Volunteers sign-up for the four subcommittees; organizational meetings will be organized for each, Chairs chosen and a schedule of meetings and work tasks established.
