INVITATION TO BID

Separate sealed bids for construction of Oak Island Railroad Crossing Quiet Zone Improvements Project in the City of Revere, City Bid No. MUN-2017-1009 will be received by the City of Revere Purchasing Department Agent, Marie Zelandi, at her office, Revere City Hall, 281 Broadway, Revere, MA, prior to 10:00 am, June 29, 2017, and at that time and place bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. Time stamp in the Purchasing Office shall govern the time.

The work of this Contract includes, but is not necessarily limited to the installation of surface mounted channelization posts and new traffic control signage for an at grade railroad crossing on Oak Island Road and Bridge Street, site clearing, the installation of a vehicle turnaround and parking area with a stone infiltration drainage trench, sidewalk construction, and full width paving. Section 01010 includes a map showing the location of work included in this Contract.

All bidders must be prequalified by MassDOT. Contact the Construction Contract Engineer, MassDOT, Suite 6260, 10 Park Plaza, Boston, MA 02116 (857-368-9522). Prospective bidders are not expected to submit a R109 form. Contractors may obtain informational copies of the bid documents, but will not be considered an eligible bidder without having obtained MassDOT prequalification prior to the date and time of the bid opening. The contract will only be awarded to a MassDOT prequalified contractor.

The total Contract Time shall be 180 calendar days. The Contractor shall comply with the following deadlines:

- Phase I to be completed by August 1, 2017;
- Phase II to be completed by October 1, 2017;
- Phase III to be completed by November 17, 2017;
- Miscellaneous additional contract work to be completed within Contract Time.

All construction activities necessary to fully complete the work identified in Phase I, Phase II, and Phase III shall be completed within 135 consecutive calendar days, commencing ten (10) days following the effective date of the Agreement.

Contract Documents may be examined and/or obtained at Revere City Hall, Office of the Purchasing Agent, 281 Broadway, Revere, MA, 02151. Revere City Hall hours are 8:15 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday through Thursday and 8:15 AM through 12:15PM on Fridays. Contract Documents will be available on June 15, 2017 at 10:00 A.M. Contract Documents are available for examination online at <http://dodgeprojects.construction.com/>

A deposit of \$50 in money order, bank or certified check payable to the City of Revere, Massachusetts will be required for each set of the Contract Documents. A refund of the deposit will be made for such Documents returned in good condition within 30 days after the Bids are received.

Bidders requesting Contract Documents by mail shall include a separate money order, bank certified or certified check in the amount of \$25 per set, made payable to the City of Revere to cover costs of handling and mailing.

Bids shall be submitted in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders and be accompanied by a Bid Security, satisfactory to the City, in the amount of five percent of the Bid. Surety is to be in the form of a certified, cashiers or treasurers check, drawn on a responsible bank or trust company; or bid bond issued by a company licensed to do business in the Commonwealth.

Bids are to be sealed in an envelope, marked on the outside with the words "Oak Island Railroad Crossing Quiet Zone Improvements, City Bid No. MUN-2017-1009" and returned to the Purchasing Department prior to the opening date and time.

Bidders may not withdraw their Bids for a period of thirty days, excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays after the actual date of the opening of the Bids.

The Successful Bidder must furnish a 100 percent Performance Bond and a 100 percent Payment Bond with a surety company acceptable to the Owner.

Complete instructions for filing Bids are included in the Instructions to Bidders.

Minimum Wage Rates as determined by the Commissioner of Department of Workforce Development under the provisions of the Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 149, Section 26 to 27H, as amended, apply to this project. It is the responsibility of the Contractor, before bid opening, to request if necessary, any additional information on Minimum Wage Rates for those tradespeople who may be employed for the proposed work under this Contract.

The bidding and award of this Contract will be under the provisions of M.G.L. Chapter 30, Section 39M.

The Owner reserves the right to waive any informality in or to reject any or all Bids if deemed to be in its best interest.

The work under this Contract is funded by the City of Revere.
