YARD WASTE: WEEK OF DECEMBER 10

On yard waste collection weeks noted above under each month, leaves, grass and other easily raked material will be picked up on your trash day. Brush can be NO wider than 3 inches in diameter and 4 feet in length. No mulch or dirt, no stumps, logs, rocks or stone will be collected. **All materials must be in brown paper leaf bags or open barrels.** Bags or barrels cannot exceed 50 pounds in weight. Christmas trees (NO yard waste) will be picked up during the first two (2) full weeks of January.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW



Recycling is collected every other week on your regular trash collection day. Your recycling and trash must be placed curbside by 7:00 A.M. Please utilize the tote provided by the City. Certain areas of the City have been designated for collection purposes as a RED collection week and the remainder of the City has been identified as GREEN collection week. All GREEN weeks are collected during the weeks highlighted in GREEN. All RED weeks are collected during the weeks NOT highlighted on the calendar. Bins containing improper materials will not be picked up. If you have any

BULKY ITEMS—CURBSIDE PICKUP—Refers to, but not limited to: tables, chairs, sofas, loveseats, bureaus, shelving, coffee tables, end tables, entertainment centers, mirrors, beds, box springs, mattresses, bicycles, and lawn furniture. Rugs should be no longer than 4 feet in length, rolled and tied. Limit of 3 items per month. Residents **must purchase a sticker** at the Board of Health for each item. Stickers range in price from \$3 to \$15 depending on the item.

SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING

What is Single Stream Recycling? This collection method allows you to place **ALL** your recyclables into one container. You do not have to separate your paper, plastic, metal or glass. No sorting is necessary.

Please rinse all glass bottles and jars, aluminum, tin, steel cans and lids. All plastic bottles, jars, tubs and plastic microwave trays/containers. Caps, lids, pumps, wraps, labels and detergent spouts may be left on. All paper and cardboard must be clean and dry. Corrugated cardboard, flatten, cut up 3' x 3' x 1' or less, box or bundle, do not use string, if cardboard will not fit into your tote, place beside or under your tote. Flatten all cardboard, cereal and snack boxes after removing plastic-coated liners. You can also recycle newspaper, white paper, colored paper, glossy newspaper inserts, brochures, junk mail, manila envelopes, phonebooks (remove covers), envelopes (remove plastic window), and brown paper bags.

Do not recycle: plastic-coated paper, tissue or pizza boxes.

APPLIANCES

Capitol Waste Services will pick up appliances including air conditioners, and microwave ovens curbside every other Friday. Pickups are by appointment only. Residents must purchase a sticker at the Revere Board of Health for each item. Stickers are \$20 each, \$12 for head of household seniors as defined by the Department of Elder Affairs.



IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Trash and recycling **must** be placed curbside by 7:00 A.M. . Trash barrels when full **cannot** exceed 50 pounds. The ideal trash container is 32 gallons. Large trash totes (64-96 gallon) are designed for automated collection and are **NOT** an acceptable container for trash collection. You may place additional trash in mint bags on the ground next to your barrel. All trash bags put on the ground must be rodent-resistant bags.
