FINAL NOTICE

Dear Water Customer,

The Revere Department of Public Works, Water and Sewer Division, in cooperation with Baystate Winsupply Co., the City's contractor responsible for the installation of the City's new water meters, is providing you with this Final Notice because you have failed to respond to the City's prior three notices to schedule a time to replace your existing water meter with a new water meter at the above service address. **The installation of the new water meter is MANDATORY. There is NO CHARGE for installation of the new meter equipment.** Every property in the City of Revere that utilizes municipal water and sewer service is required to replace their old water meter with a new water meter.

It is imperative that you call Baystate Winsupply Co. IMMEDIATELY TO SCHEDULE YOUR APPOINTMENT AT 1-866-983-8080. If you have not scheduled your appointment WITHIN 1 WEEK OF THIS NOTICE, the City will take the following further action: a \$5,000 water usage charge will be placed on your water and sewer bill until the new water meter is installed. This charge reflects the City of Revere's costs associated with the delay in implementing the replacement program, including the City's costs to manually read the old water meter.

Please be advised if a new water meter is not installed in a timely fashion this \$5,000 charge may result in a lien placed on your property. This \$5,000 charge will be removed from you water/sewer bill once the new water meter is installed.

If you feel you have received this letter in error, please contact Baystate Winsupply Co. at the above number immediately to prevent further action. If you are not responsible for scheduling this work, such as in the case of a tenant or renter of the property, please pass this on to the owner.

The City of Revere requires your cooperation with this very important project.
